

Terms and Conditions of C.V.L.G.A competitions

1. Competitors must be members of the C.V.L.G.A.
2. WHS and R & A Rules to apply
3. Active handicaps only - handicaps will be verified
4. The Committee's decision shall be final
5. No entry fees will be returned after the draw has been made, other than in the case of ineligibility due to a handicap change.
6. All entrants must have played three qualifying rounds in the previous 12 months
7. Handicap index limits:
 - Silver Championship - 20.4 maximum
 - Bronze Championship - 20.5 to 46.6
 - Team of Three – the sum of the three handicaps must not exceed 120.
 - 4BBB – there will be three categories for prizes and categories will be calculated dependent on size of field and entries received. The highest total score overall will win the trophy
 - Mixed 4BBB - Ladies 42 and Gentlemen 28 maximum. (Ladies and Gents with a higher handicap index may still play but will receive the maximum handicap index)
8. Tees – Ladies will play from the ladies' competition tees. Gents will play from the yellow tees.
9. Buggies – A current medical certificate will be required for the Silver and Bronze Championships. An email request is required to the Competitions Secretary for all other competitions.
10. Formats:
 - Silver Championship – 18 holes medal (handicap qualifying)

The best 24 gross scores qualify for the match play knockout rounds played off scratch on the 2nd and 3rd days of the Championship.

The top 16 players compete for the Sylvia Barron Trophy and the next 8 compete for the Cupboard Trophy

Nett prizes - Playing handicaps to be calculated at 95% of course handicap (rounded up or down)

- Bronze Championship – 18 holes stableford (handicap qualifying)

Playing handicaps to be calculated as 95% of course handicap (rounded up or down).

- Team of Three – Stableford, with the best two scores to count on each hole. Playing handicaps to be calculated as 85% of course handicap (rounded up or down)
- 4BBB – Stableford, with the best score to count on each hole. Playing handicaps to be calculated as 85% of course handicap (rounded up or down)
- Mixed 4BBB – Stableford, with the best score to count on each hole. Playing handicaps to be calculated as 85% of course handicap (rounded up or down)
